



Fine Arts Department Audition information 2017-2018

Cardinal Gibbons High School offers an extensive Fine Arts curriculum for grades 9-12. Courses in Choral Ensemble, Dance, Drama, Instrumental Music, Technical Theatre, and Visual Art are available. Students are required to complete one Fine Art credit for graduation. Freshmen may elect to enroll in Choral Ensemble, Band, Dance, Percussion, Strings, or Technical Theater. Qualifying freshmen may take Drama I, Guitar I, Guitar II or Visual Art I. Freshmen may join Fine Arts Clubs and audition for school plays.

- January 18/23 **Band Placement Auditions** are at 3:30-5:30 by appointment in the band classroom 135. Please RSVP to Mr. Cashin, Band Director, at mcashin@cghsnc.org. Students may play any major scales that they know, and two small excerpts of music from a recent band concert. Make-up auditions are by appointment only. **The deferment policy for Health/PE applies.**
- January 21 **Chorus auditions** for Choral Ensemble are at 10:00 am in the choral room 130. Please RSVP to Ms. Martha Zaldivar, Choral instructor, at mzaldivar@cghsnc.org. **The deferment policy for Health/PE applies**
- January 19 **Dance II auditions** will be held at 3:30 pm in the dance classroom 133. Please RSVP to Ms. Brooks Owens, Dance instructor at bowens@cghsnc.org. **Dance I does not require an audition but deferment policy for Health/PE applies.**
- January 28 **Drama I placement auditions** will be held from 1:00-5:00 P.M. in the CGHS Theaters. Please plan on being in attendance for the full four hours. Students should prepare a short (1 minute) memorized monologue, speech or poem to present. Students will also participate in a series of improv exercises and theater games. Students are advised to wear comfortable clothing, as this will be an active day. - January 20 **Visual Art I** requires two pencil drawings on separate sheets of 8.5"x11" paper clearly labeled with the student's first and last name and return address. Image one should be a still life arrangement of three or more objects and image two should be the corner of any room including objects from the room. Deferment Policy for Health/PE: Freshmen at Cardinal Gibbons High School who are pursuing a 3-4-year sequence in a Fine Art may defer the Health/PE requirement. If the student continues in the same Fine Art course of study for grade 10, the College Counseling Department will provide an independent study for completion of the Health/PE requirement at the end of the sophomore year. Only those students enrolling in the same Fine Art course of study for two consecutive years may defer the Health/PE credit.
